The city offers a unique blend of modern infrastructure, vibrant markets, beautiful beaches, rich cultural heritage, and a rapidly expanding technology ecosystem.

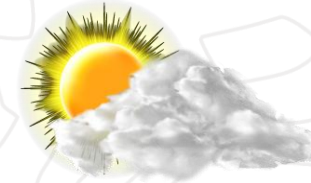

November is generally warm, so lightweight clothing is recommended during the day, while a light jacket is useful in air-conditioned venues or during evening activities.

Safety

Cotonou is generally considered one of the safer cities in West Africa for visitors. As with any international destination, remain aware of your surroundings, avoid displaying valuables in public, use licensed taxis or trusted ride-hailing services, and keep copies of your important travel documents.

Benin Republic is the **first Francophone country** to host the AfriLabs Annual Gathering, reflecting AfriLabs' commitment to strengthening collaboration across both Anglophone and Francophone innovation ecosystems.

Visa & Immigration

Benin Republic has simplified its entry process through an electronic visa (e-Visa) system, making travel convenient for international visitors. Delegates are encouraged to check the latest visa requirements well in advance of their departure and apply early to avoid delays.

Do I Need a Visa?

Visa requirements vary depending on your nationality. Citizens of ECOWAS Member States and all African countries may enter Benin visa-free for stays of up to 90 days, subject to prevailing immigration regulations. Travellers from other countries are generally required to obtain a Benin e-Visa before travelling.

To check whether your country is visa-exempt, view the official list of countries with visa waiver agreements [here](#). If you require a visa, you can submit your application through the official Benin e-Visa portal <https://evisa.bj/>. Delegates are encouraged to apply at least 7 days before departure to allow sufficient processing time.

Applying for a Benin e-Visa

The Benin e-Visa application is completed online. Applicants are generally required to provide:

- A valid passport with at least **six (6) months' validity** beyond the date of entry
- A recent passport-sized photograph
- A completed online visa application form
- Proof of accommodation (hotel reservation or invitation letter)
- Return or onward flight ticket
- Payment of the applicable visa fee

Once approved, the e-Visa is issued electronically and should be printed or saved on a mobile device for presentation upon arrival.



Immigration on Arrival

Upon arrival at **Cadjehoun International Airport (COO)** in Cotonou, travellers may be required to present:

- Valid passport
- Approved e-Visa (where applicable)
- Return or onward ticket
- Hotel reservation or accommodation details
- Invitation letter (if requested)
- Proof of sufficient funds for the duration of stay
- Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate (where applicable)

Immigration officers may ask a few routine questions regarding the purpose of your visit and the duration of your stay, it is part of the process, ensure you cooperate with them.

Invitation Letters

Registered delegates who require an official invitation letter to support their visa application may request one through the AAG 2026 registration portal or by contacting the AfriLabs Events Team.

Please note that an invitation letter **does not guarantee visa approval**. The issuance of visas remains the sole responsibility of the Government of Benin and its diplomatic missions.



Important Travel Advice

- Apply for your visa as early as possible.
- Ensure your passport has at least **two blank visa pages**.
- Carry both printed and digital copies of your travel documents.
- Keep your passport, visa, and other important documents with you at all times during your journey.
- Check that your passport remains valid for at least six months beyond your planned departure date from Benin.

Getting Around Cotonou



Getting around Cotonou is convenient, with several transportation options available for delegates.

- **Ride-hailing Apps:** **Yango** and **Gozem** are the safest and most convenient ways to travel around the city. Both offer reliable, affordable rides and cashless payment options.
- **Taxis:** Licensed taxis are widely available at the airport, hotels, and major attractions. Agree on the fare before your journey if the taxi is not metered.
- **Motorcycle Taxis (Zémidjans):** A fast and inexpensive way to navigate traffic, though they are recommended only for short trips.
- **Conference Shuttle:** Complimentary shuttle services will operate between the official conference hotels and the event venue during AAG 2026. The schedule will be shared with registered delegates.
- **Airport Transfers:** Cadjehoun International Airport (COO) is approximately 15–20 minutes from most major hotels. Delegates may use conference shuttles, hotel transfers, ride-hailing apps, or licensed airport taxis.

Travel Tip: For a safe and hassle-free experience, AfriLabs recommends using the conference shuttle service, **Yango**, or **Gozem** throughout your stay in Cotonou.

Things to Bring Along

- Travel insurance documents
- Printed and digital copies of important travel documents

Health & Personal Care

- Prescription medications (with a doctor's prescription if necessary)
- Basic first-aid kit
- Mosquito repellent
- Hand sanitizer and personal toiletries
- Reusable water bottle

Travel Tip:

Keep your passport, visa, vaccination certificate, and other important documents in your carry-on luggage, and save digital copies on your phone or cloud storage for easy access in case of loss or emergency.



Things to Bring Along

To ensure a smooth and comfortable stay in Benin Republic, we recommend packing the following essentials for AAG 2026.

Money & Payments

- Debit or credit cards (Visa and Mastercard widely accepted)
- Some cash in **West African CFA Franc (XOF)** or USD/EUR for exchange
- Small denominations of cash for taxis, markets, and tips

Tech & Connectivity

- Mobile phone (preferably unlocked for a local SIM card)
- Laptop and charger
- Power bank
- Chargers for all electronic devices
- Universal travel adapter (**Type C & Type E plugs**, 220–230V, 50Hz)
- Portable Wi-Fi or MiFi device (optional)

Embassy & Consular Support

We recommend saving the contact details of your country's embassy or consulate in Benin before you travel. If your country does not have diplomatic representation in Benin, identify the nearest accredited embassy that can provide consular assistance in case of a lost passport or other emergencies.

Health & Medical Assistance

If you require medical attention:

- Visit the nearest hospital or healthcare facility.
- Carry your travel medical insurance details and identification at all times.
- If you have any existing medical conditions or allergies, inform your travel companions and accommodation provider.

Explore Benin's Rich History

Ouidah – One of West Africa's most historic towns, known for the ***Door of No Return, the Slave Route, and the Sacred Forest***. Located about **45 km (1 hour)** from Cotonou.

Fondation Zinsou Museum – Discover contemporary African art and Benin's rich cultural heritage through world-class exhibitions.

Visit Ganvié – The "Venice of Africa"

Take a boat tour to **Ganvié**, Africa's largest lake village, where thousands of people live in stilt houses built over **Lake Nokoué**.

This UNESCO-recognized cultural site offers a fascinating glimpse into Benin's history and way of life.

Relax at Fidjrossè Beach

Enjoy the Atlantic coastline at **Fidjrossè Beach**, one of Cotonou's most popular beaches, perfect for relaxing, dining, or watching the sunset after a day of conference activities.

Shop at Arts and Crafts Market (Gbégamey)

Experience one of West Africa's largest open-air markets, where you can shop for traditional fabrics, handcrafted souvenirs, spices, jewellery, artwork, and local products.
